MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL PARISH MEETING HELD ON TUESDAY 4th MAY 2021 FROM 7.00PM VIA REMOTE ACCESS.

2. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE – none COUNCILLORS DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST – none

6. PUBLIC OPPORTUNITY FOR QUESTIONS TO COUNCILLORS

Fly tipping of builders rubble on the side of Holt House Lane was reported by a parishioner who also raised the road at Mintlyn Farm had been closed by NCC and was concerned that this would lead to further fly tipping in our parish. This closure would also lead to further parking issues and have a potential effect on our roads.

AP advised that there was an increase countrywide with fly tipping and this would be put on the agenda for the June meeting, along with the road closure.

CM has received a recent email regarding litter chares by the County Council and the Borough are looking at issues with landowners who have fly tipping on their land. He was hopeful that further assistance was forthcoming, and the Borough are looking to pursue and prosecute with a fixed penalty of £300. AP raised that the charges at the recycling centres encouraged fly tipping which made little sense as the cost to the County Council to clear was expensive.

JL noted that the gates on the Mintlyn Farm Road had signs stating 24hr CCTV in operation and queried if these were working? He also raised the issue of displacement parking and seasonal parking. JE gave an update from the recent anti-social behaviour meeting with the police who advised that once the proposed Bawsey new car park was running, we then have a good chance of taking the seasonal parking further. Seasonal parking would include enforcement and prosecution. CM advised that NCC make the legislation for seasonal parking and it is a civil not criminal matter. It was agreed that we should look for help from our new County Councillor upon election.
